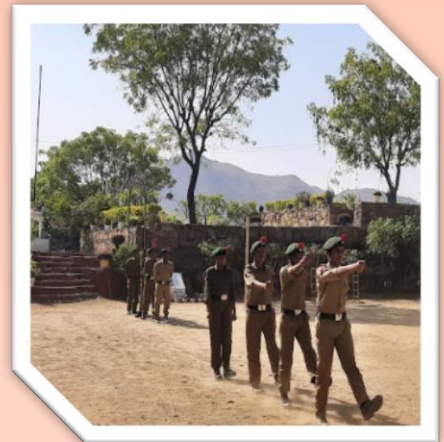
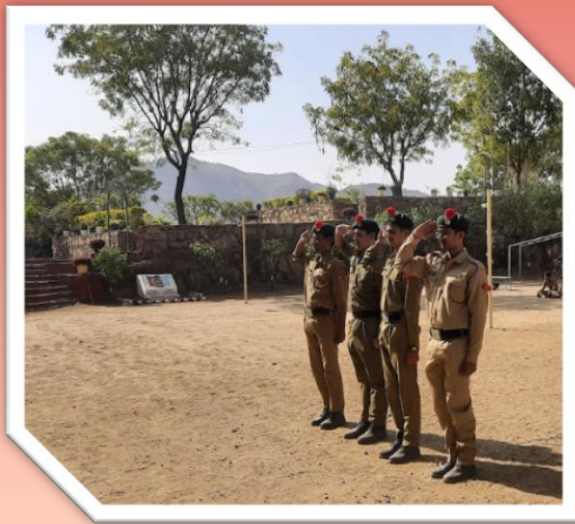

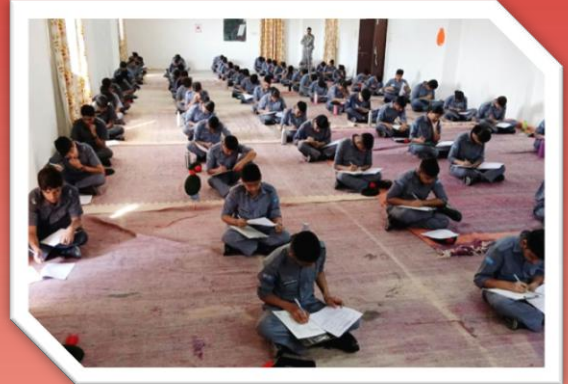
YOUNG CADETS DEMONSTRATE SKILL AND PRECISION DURING THE NCC ASSESSMENT!

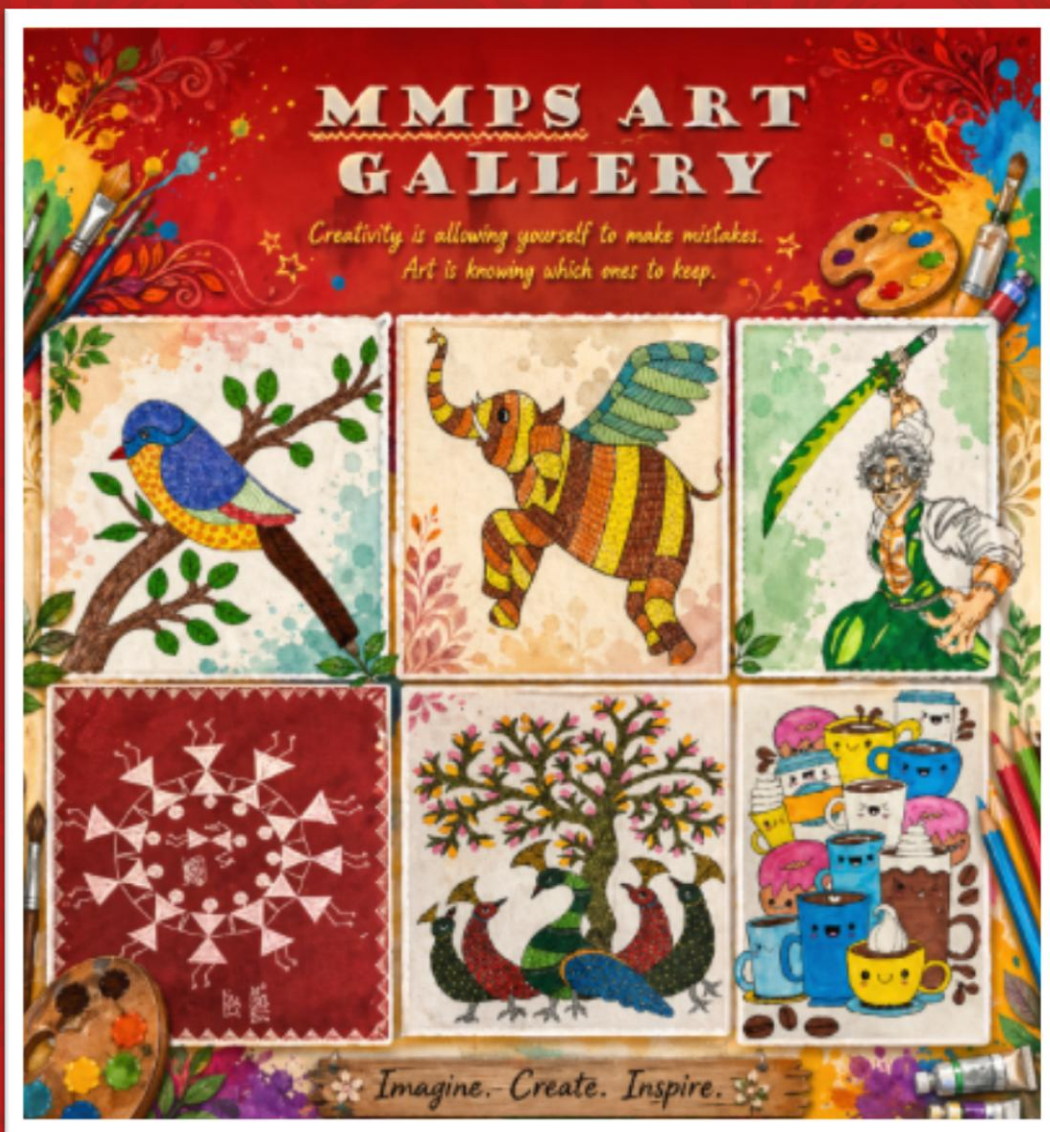
